Frequently Asked Questions:

1. Can seniors be exempt from semester 2 exams?

Yes. Senior exemptions are allowed for Final Exams. *See the Senior Exemption process document and application.*

2. Can students take exams early?

A student may not take a final exam prior to May 12th. If a student is absent during the exam time, he/she must make up the exam upon his/her return.

3. What do I do if a student is absent for an exam?

The student must make arrangements with the teacher to make up the exam. Make-up exams must be completed by Wednesday, May 20th.

4. Do I have to turn in a copy of my exams and if so, to whom do I give them?

Yes. Please submit an electronic copy of your exam and answer key to Troy Beall by May 11th.

5. Am I required to give my students a semester exam?

All classes are required to give students a final exam on the designated exam days. These assessments are worth 20% of the semester grade. EOC courses are an exception to this grading policy (see the next FAQ for further information).

6. How are grades entered for EOC courses?

These exams will count as a standard test in EOC courses. Enter an X for the exam grade in the exam tab of your gradebook. Enter the midterm as a Quarter 4 test grade.

7. How can students pick up their caps and gowns if they are exempt from their final exams?

Students can visit the CCHS Media Center on Thursday, May 14th (last name A-L) or Friday, May 15th (last name M-Z) between 10:02 and 12:00 to pick them up.
